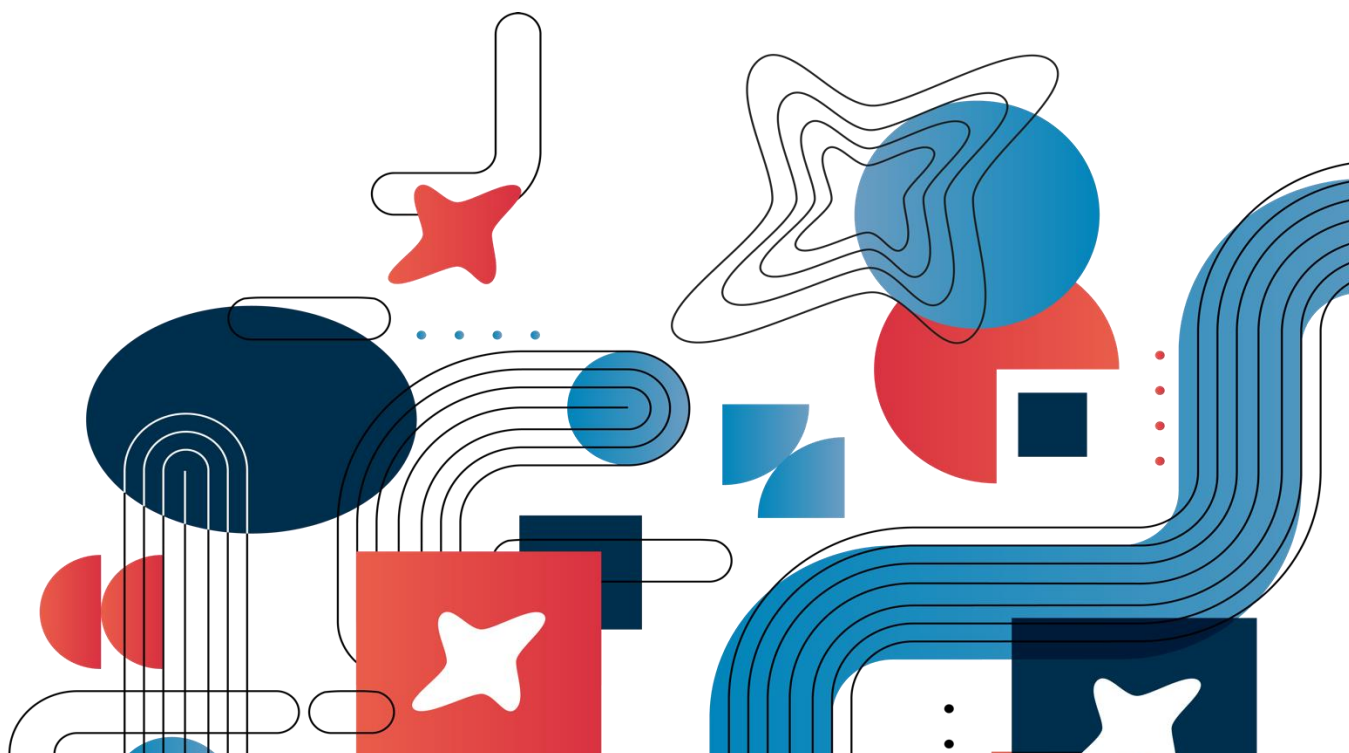




Club Affiliation Guidelines 2024

Introduction:

Welcome to British Roundnet and the exciting world of roundnet! These guidelines outline the requirements for club affiliation with British Roundnet, the benefits of affiliation, and the various tiers available. Whether you're an individual looking to start a new club or an existing club looking to join British Roundnet, this document will provide you with the necessary information.

Why become a BR Affiliated Club?

Affiliating with British Roundnet offers clubs various benefits, including:

1. Run a British Roundnet Sanctioned Event
2. Your club on the new British Roundnet Club Finder (Launching December 2023)
3. Access to the BR Club Forum, meeting bi-monthly.
4. Access to British Roundnet club only tournaments in 2024
5. Eligibility for national team selection.
6. Recognition and support from British Roundnet organization.
7. Opportunities for club promotion and growth.

Who can set up a British Roundnet Affiliated club?

- Anyone can start a club, as long as you have a group of six players and affiliating your club is totally free!
- Clubs must be located in England, Wales or Scotland.
- All club players must be members of British Roundnet
- Club Affiliation is on an annual basis and must be renewed each year.

Club Tiers:



- Minimum 6 players.
- Appoint a Club Captain.
- Register your club with a unique name and provide basic information.



- Minimum 15 players.
- Fulfill all requirements for **Bronze** Club affiliation.
- Design and display a club logo.
- Establish a club organization structure, including positions like Captain, Finance/Treasurer, and Secretary (and be able to demonstrate this on a PDF document).
- Host at least one public event on the Fwango platform per year (either sanctioned or unsanctioned).



- Minimum 25 players.
- Fulfill all requirements for **Bronze** and **Silver** Club affiliation.
- Have a Coach with a British Roundnet Level 1 Qualification.
- Host at least three public events on the Fwango platform per year (either sanctioned or unsanctioned)



- Minimum 50 players.
- Fulfill all requirements for **Bronze**, **Silver**, and **Gold** Club affiliation.

6. Application Process:

- Clubs interested in affiliating with British Roundnet must submit an application through the designated process via this application form:

- Applications will be reviewed by British Roundnet's Affiliation Committee, and approval will be based on meeting the requirements for the desired club tier.

7. Affiliation Renewal:

- Clubs must renew their affiliation annually to maintain their benefits and recognition within the British Roundnet community.

8. Termination of Affiliation:

- British Roundnet reserves the right to terminate club affiliation for non-compliance with these guidelines or any violation of British Roundnet's rules and values.
